TRADITION AND PROGRESS


In 1761 , Kaspar Faber manufactured the first "Bleyweißstifte". In 1840 Lothar von Faber marked the pencils with his name, established the standard for length, diameter and lead hardpencils into real quality world's first branded writing implement. In 1849, the first foreign ness and turned his products and the branches were opened in New York, London and Paris. In 1898, Baroness Ottilie von Faber
 married Count Alexander zu Castell-Rüdenhausen. The marriage re sulted in the famous company name Faber-Castell. In 1905 , the legendary Castell 9000 was created by Count Alexander von Faber-Castell, which with its unmistakable design continues to enjoy great success worldwide. As and from 1928, Count Roland
 von Faber-Castell $\qquad$ took over management of the company He acquired a majority share in Lapis Johann Faber S/A, Brazil, which is today the
 largest factory for graphite and colour pencils in the world. By establishing inter national production sites and sales companies, Faber-Castell grew to be the world's leading producer of wood-cased graphite and colour pencils. In 1978 Count Anton W. von Faber-Castell became head of the company now in its 8 th generation. He focusses strongly on new products (including cosmetic pencils) and the expansion of the company's international activities with the aim of establishing FABER-CASTELL as a true global brand.

More than 2500 employees and guests from the worlds of politics, art and industry came from all over the world, underlining the company's international focus. FABERCASTELL has again proven that tradition and innovation need not be mutually exclusive, and that the creative powers of FABER-CASTELL continue to be effective. The unique GRIP graphite and coloured pencils with their patented grip zones have been highly successful, and have proven that there is always room for improvements, even in something as apparently simple as a pencil. Shortly after its introduction, the GRIP 2001 pencil had already won four major design prizes and the US magazine Business Week went as far as honouring it as "Product of the Year 2000". The new Jumbo GRIP graphite and coloured pencils were voted "Product of the Year 2002" by the "pbs" German stationers' association, and were nominated for the German Design Prize 2002. These successes and the positive international development of the FABERCASTELL brand are the result of the consistent application of the company's mission statement, which was formulated 150 years ago. The promise to offer only the best quality in each product segment worldwide remains one of the most important elements in our company philosophy up to the present day.
